#### Geriatric Emergency Medicine

Het aantal oudere patienten op de SEH is stijgende. Veel van deze oudere patienten hebben complexe comorbiditeiten, zijn kwetsbaar en hebben een verhoogd risico op slechte uitkomsten. Werken met kwetsbare oudere patienten kan lastig zijn in een omgeving waar tijdsdruk en onrust op de loer liggen en het wordt steeds belangrijker om goed met deze groep patienten om te kunnen gaan.

Deze praktische precursose heeft het doel om kennis en kunde over 'Geriatric Emergency

'Medicine' van SEH-artsen te verbeteren. De precursose is een halve dag en bestaat na een korte introductie uit werkgroepen met casus en scenario's. The cases range from lack of flow (ischemia – how to detect and when to reperfuse or not to reperfuse) to flooding of the brain (hemorrhages and hyperperfusion in CT perfusion).

The use of point-of-care ultrasound by Emergency Physicians in guiding invasive procedures is growing rapidly. It is essential to work safely, while adapting to the new possibilities that ultrasound guided procedures offer. During this workshop you will learn to perform ultrasound guided peripheral and central venous access, and upper & lower extremity nerve blocks.
